New data protection regulations came into force on 25th May 2018, called the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). The aim of these new regulations is to reinforce the protection already set out in the existing Data Protection rules by ensuring that personal data is kept safe and secure.

Whilst we already had procedures in place which adhered to the Data Protection Act 1998 to keep your data safe, the new regulations will reinforce these existing requirements.

We have updated our Data Protection & Privacy Policy to become GDPR compliant and to give you confidence about how we look after your personal data.

The Club needs to hold certain personal data about you so that we can contact you, advise you on club matters and carry out club administration.

Please make yourself aware of our Data Protection & Privacy Policy which is available on the club's website. It is important that you read this policy so that you are fully aware of how your personal data is kept safe.

Where you have provided us with personal data about other individuals, such as family members, dependants or other club members, please ensure that those individuals are also aware of the information contained within the Policy.

We will contact you about information relating to your membership or participation in the sport. However, as the Club has a strong social element we may distribute information about other events and matters which may be of interest to members.
